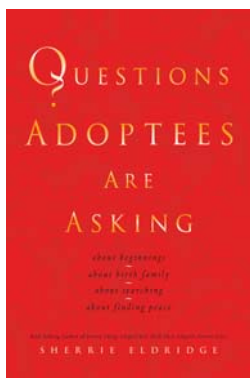


Questions Adoptees Are Asking
