In early October, the Post Adoption Support Service, Relationships Australia, is offering a 2 day workshop, 'The Tree of Life' for children who have been adopted.

The 'Tree of Life' is a strengths focused activity which utilises a Narrative approach. Using the 'Tree of Life' as a metaphor, each child will create their own Tree and explore their identity using art and conversations. Participants will identify and represent that which enhance and support their life, including people and places of significance, both past and present, their individual strengths and gifts, and their hopes and dreams. The process provides a safe place in which children can also explore any difficulties that they may be facing and the strategies that they are successfully using to respond to these difficulties.

This workshop is specifically for adopted children aged between 6yrs and 11yrs of age and is limited to 10 child participants. The workshop will be facilitated by: Dianne Tilley, Early Childhood Educator, Relationships Australia (SA) and Sandi Petersen, Post Adoption Support Services, Relationships Australia (SA). Each child will invite guests to attend a special lunch and celebration on the second day.
